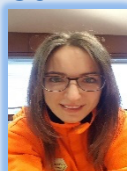

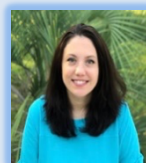

Using Supervisory Conversations to Promote Safety

Abstract:

Supervisor conversations create an opportunity to set clear expectations, gather input, identify barriers, and provide feedback about safety. These conversations can increase psychological safety and promote safe practices in the workplace. Yet, most supervisors do not typically engage in frequent safety conversations with their team. In the presentation, Nicole will discuss the value of safety conversations, outline key elements that should be included, and present a case study describing an intervention aimed at increasing safety conversations and improving safe practices at work.

Building an Ideal Safety Culture

Abstract:

You've fixed the hazards, provided better equipment, and enforced procedures. Now, how can you further improve safety? Many organizations have reached a plateau, finding that relying primarily on these approaches produces only marginal gains. A work environment that minimizes, contains, or controls serious hazards should be a necessary precondition for any safety improvement process, but that is not enough. We need to also consider how safety is either supported or hindered by the safety culture, including the interaction of equipment, facilities, procedures, and people. This presentation will highlight the importance of taking a more comprehensive approach and overview continuous improvement activities for building an ideal safety culture, including the Physical Environment/ Conditions, Leadership, Management Systems, Safe and At-Risk Behaviors, Employee Engagement, and Attitudes/Perceptions.
